

FORCE MAJEURE: HOW INDUSTRY CAN WIN AUDIENCES OFF THE SOFA AND BACK TO THE CINEMAS

THE DISRUPTION, lockdowns and overall impact COVID has had on the past few years seems to be over and the entire cultural sector now faces the same issue: audiences prefer to consume only the biggest shows and productions, while independent content is suffering. Attracting people back to cultural spaces has become a major challenge, for society as a whole as well as the film sector. The industry is trying to address this social challenge and, in this session, we will learn about new initiatives to win audiences back to the big screen to watch European stories.

ATTACHMENT

ATTACHMENT is a horror romance about Maja, a hasbeen actress that falls in love with Leah, a young, Jewish academic from London. When Leah suffers a mysterious seizure, Maja fears their whirlwind romance might be cut short and decides to join Leah back to her home in the Hasidic area of Stamford Hill, London. There, Maja meets her new downstairs neighbour, Leah's mother, Chana. An overbearing and secretive woman, Chana seems resistant to all of Maja's attempts to win her over. Maja notices strange occurrences in the building, and she begins to suspect that Chana's secrets could be much darker than first anticipated and the woman she loves might be carrying the biggest secret of all.



GABRIEL BIER GISLASON is a director and screenwriter. Graduating as a director and screenwriter from New York University. Bier Gislason makes his feature film debut with *Attachment* (2022), which had its world premiere at Tribeca Film Festival.

BAND

THREE ICELANDIC BANDMATES, Álfrún, Saga and Hrefna, from The Post Performance Blues Band, are tired of playing for an audience of five at their gigs and getting paid in beer. Each of them is staring down 40 and struggling to juggle being mothers and their artistic pursuits. They decide to give themselves one more year to either become pop stars or leave the band for good. What follows is a make-it-or-break-it story about a band that is not really a band. A music group with performance art. This is a movie about sisterhood set to beautiful Iceland.



ÁLFRÚN ÖRNÓLFSDÓTTIR is an actress, director and author. She has written a play, a script for a TV series and staged a play with her own troupe, acted in films and numerous plays at the City Theatre, the National Theatre, LA and

with independent groups. Álfrún is one of the members of The Post Performance Blues Band, which conducts artistic research at the boundaries of music, visual art and performing arts with feminist events.

BUBBLE

BUBBLE is the story of 16-year-old small town girl Eveliina, whose world collapses when she finds out her mother is having an affair with a woman. Like all teens, Eveliina thinks liberally, and wants her own freedom of thought and action - but that thinking does not really extend to her own parents. She tries to stop her mother's affair at all costs and get her parents to fall in love again, with both dramatic and comedic consequences.



ALEKSI SALMENPERÄ is a Finnish filmmaker whose works have premiered in major film festivals such as Berlinale (*A Bad Family*, 2009), HotDocs (*Alcan Highway*, 2013) and San Sebastian (*A Man's Job*, 2007). He won the Finnish film

award Jussi for Best Director with *Distractions* (2015) and *Void* (2018) which was also named Best Film.

BURN ALL MY LETTERS

BASED ON the 2018 best-selling book of the same name, which in turn is based on real events. The story spans 70 years and several generations. After a fierce argument with his wife, successful author Alex realizes that he must get to the bottom of the issues that plague him to save his marriage from collapse. Through diaries and letters, he begins a journey into his own childhood memories and as far back as the 1930s. He uncovers a secret, and potentially dangerous, love triangle involving his maternal grandparents, both famous and recognized authors in their own right.



BJÖRN RUNGE is is renowned for his unique way of directing actors and recently helmed the critically acclaimed 2017 film *The Wife* with Glenn Close. Glenn Close won a Golden Globe for her role and was also Oscar nominated for

best female actress. His 2003 film *Daybreak* won the Silver Berlin Bear, was nominated for a Gold Berlin Bear and won *Der Blaue Engel* at Berlin Film festival.

BOY FROM HEAVEN

ADAM, THE SON OF A FISHERMAN, is offered the ultimate privilege to study at the Al-Azhar University in Cairo, the epicenter of power of Sunni Islam. Shortly after his arrival in Cairo, the university's highest ranking religious leader, the Grand Imam, suddenly dies and Adam soon becomes a pawn in a ruthless power struggle between Egypt's religious and political elites.



TARIK SALEH directed and wrote the award-winning box office hit *The Nile Hilton Incident* (2017). He has directed *The Contractor* (2022), several episodes of the HBO-series *Westworld* (2018) and Showtime series *Ray Donovan* as well as

the thriller *Tommy* (2014). His film debut *Metropia* (2009) premiered at the Venice Film Festival, he has also directed the documentaries *Gitmo: The New Rules of War* (2005) and *Sacrificio: Who Betrayed Che Guevara* (2001) with Erik Gandini. Tarik Saleh is a co-founder of the production company Atmo with producer Kristina Åberg.

BULLETS

12-YEAR-OLD ABDEL lives in a segregated area, but has an aptitude for school. When his friend Bashir is asked to start dealing drugs for the local gang, Abdel gets drawn into criminal activities. Bashir gets in trouble and Abdel is forced to help him out. By doing so he inadvertently discloses the whereabouts of the gang's hideout. A rival gang launches a retaliatory raid, one of the gang members is killed and Abdel gets the blame.



PETER PONTIKIS studied psychology at the University of Stockholm and video and photography at the Royal Institute of Art in Stockholm. His thesis *The Gift* (2006) played at festivals like Karlovy Vary and Mar Del Plata. In 2008 he made

the cult feature *Not Like Others*, a moody vampire drama, and in 2014 the award-winning short *Boy-Razor*.

As part of the Swedish Film Institutes Shortfilm Horror Initiative *It's Alive*, Peter directed the first Swedish virtual-reality fiction project: *Oh Deer!* (2016), a short experimental horror in 3D. *Bullets* is his second feature.

ICELAND IN THE 1940'S. Bjarni, a young, idealistic farmer has a place in this world; a family farm, status and respect in the community. He is in an apparently perfect marriage to the beautiful and hard-working Unnur, but underneath the bright surface, a silent anguish is growing between husband and wife, too painful to talk about.

On the neighbouring farm lives the intelligent and lovely Helga, a mother of two. Her poetic mind is trapped in farm life and in a marriage with a man who was never her equal. Bjarni and Helga's shared love for literature leads to rumours of an affair, and ironically this is what eventually drives them together. A passionate, forbidden affair begins with emotions running as wild as the ocean waves that surround them.

and a half years. Known as «Norway's most primitive art residency» people now live there for free to connect to nature. She is now doing a MA in Fine Arts at the National Academy of Art, combining it with studies in philosophy and interdisciplinary ecology.



THE STORE

OUTSIDE THE DISCOUNT grocery store, a disparate group of homeless people have built a camp of tents and shacks. They live off dumpster diving in the store's container, and are met with aggressive resistance. Meanwhile, the store's employees slave under hardening conditions from the chain's higher-ups. Through a unique meld of liveaction footage and stop motion animation, *The Store* lets us follow the conflicts and relationships that arise between people under the heel of a profit-hungry system.


THE RIOT


